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The Nevada Registry Advisory Committee Conflict of Interest Policy

All members of The Nevada Registry Advisory Committee shall exercise the utmost good faith in all transactions relating to their duties. In their dealings with and on behalf of the committee and The Nevada Registry, they shall be held to a strict rule of honest and fair dealing between themselves and the committee. They shall not use their positions, or knowledge gained, in such a way that a material conflict, real or apparent, would arise between the interest of the Advisory Committee, The Nevada Registry and that of the individual. Any actual or threatened violation of this prohibition should be promptly disclosed.

All members of The Nevada Registry Advisory Committee shall not accept any material gifts, favors, or hospitality that might influence their decision-making or compromise their judgment in actions affecting the career ladder placement of The Nevada Registry participants. Any actual or threatened violation of this prohibition should be promptly disclosed.

Although position of divided interest with potential conflict may exist from time to time, such instances shall not be permitted to influence adversely the welfare of The Nevada Registry. Therefore, any persons subject to this policy shall promptly disclose for him/herself and members of his/her immediate family:

- a) the existence of any actual or pending employment, appointment, activity, relationship, or other position which may be of divided interest with the Advisory Committee and The Nevada Registry.
- b) the existence of any actual or pending investment, contract, conveyance, purchase, sale or other transaction directly or indirectly involving or affecting such persons and which might involve a real or apparent material conflict with the interest of the Advisory Committee and The Nevada Registry.

The disclosures required by this policy shall be made to the Registry Program Director, or in the case of disclosure by the Program Director, the Chairperson of the Advisory Committee. Each year, all members of the Advisory Committee shall complete and sign a conflict of interest statement.
