Degrees and Certificates Offered

TMCC offers two degree pathways for early childhood education majors. The AA degree is designed to transfer to a **4-year degree at either UNR or GBC.** The AAS degree is designed with more flexibility in coursework. Within the AAS degree, students can take classes on administration of preschool programs, working with infants and toddlers, or preschool age children.

- AA, Early Childhood Education (transfers to UNR & GBC)
- AAS, Early Childhood Education

There are four stackable ECE skill certificates. Students can earn skill certificates as they progress toward an AA/AAS degree in ECE, or as professional development certification for non-degree-seeking students.

- Skill Certificate, Early Childhood Educator 1 (9 credits)
- Skill Certificate, Early Childhood Educator 2 (12 credits)
- Skill Certificate, Early Childhood Educator 3 (21 credits)
- Skill Certificate, Early Childhood Educator 4 (27 credits)
